## **DEADLINE EXTENDED: Featured Composer Program**

Classical Revolution RVA is proud to present an opportunity for composers in the Richmond, Virginia area!

Classical Revolution RVA is a non-profit corporation founded to organize and present classical music events in non-traditional settings to expose new audiences to classical music. Professional composers and composition students (actively engaged in learning the art and craft of composition in a school, university, or other educational setting) are invited to apply for this program. This program is open to U.S. citizens or residents currently living, working, and/or studying in Richmond, Virginia, or in nearby counties. **The deadline for applications to this program has been extended to November 1, 2021.** 

Applicants for this program will submit one to five **existing** original compositions for review by the CRRVA Featured Composer committee, including audio recordings (mp3, wav, or midi) and scores. The committee will not review applications submitted without audio recordings or scores. The CRRVA Featured Composer committee will include individuals selected from the CRRVA Board of Directors, staff, and local musicians. The committee will evaluate applications based on musicality and the feasibility of producing live performances of the submitted works. **This program is not a competition and CRRVA is not commissioning any new works.** CRRVA will produce and perform the works of chosen composers for local audiences.

CRRVA will choose up to four composers and each will receive a \$250 stipend. CRRVA will produce a recital on December 18th at 7pm at Gallery5 in Richmond, VA to highlight the works of the chosen composers.

In December 2021, CRRVA will select one of the four composers to be the CRRVA Featured Composer for 2022 and to receive an additional \$1,000 stipend. CRRVA will facilitate the formation of ensembles and the scheduling of rehearsals to support the presentation of the Composer in Residence's existing compositions throughout 2022. No additional works will be commissioned. The Featured Composer will be recognized at CRRVA events and offered the opportunity to introduce his, her, or their works to the audience. Each chosen composer will retain ownership of the copyright for their featured works but will grant CRRVA the right to use, perform the work(s) in concert, and publish recordings of the work(s) without any further compensation for a period of one year following the announcement of the committee's decision.
